
We are in full swing of the holidays! Here are a few different places and how they celebrate.

I have taught for 12 years before teaching here.



The Wright Brothers

They were the first people to airborne and they were obsessed with how things flew like a small airplane. Did you know that the Wright brothers did it get a diploma and the Wright brothers never got married.

We celebrate the Wright brothers because it commemorates the first successful flights in a mechanically propelled airplane that was heavier-than-air. And another reason we celebrate the Wright brothers is they made the first successful mechanical airplane.


