Automatic bidding is the easiest way to bid. Simply enter the highest price you're willing to pay for an item, and we'll do the rest. Stay ahead of the competition without having to be glued to your phone! Don't worry! You will receive a text alert if you're outbid.

If you are outbid immediately after placing a bid, it's likely that another bidder is using automatic bidding and has a maximum limit higher than yours. You'll need to increase your maximum limit in order to be the highest bidder.

Use the tabs to check for items **WITHOUT** bids! This just may get you the best deal of the night.

Winners & Check-Out

All items will be available at check-out at 9:30pm. If you are unable to pickup items the evening of the auction, you can arrange a time with the school April 13-17, 2026 to pick-up your items. **SHIPPING IS NOT AVAILABLE.**

If you win an item, **PLEASE DO NOT TAKE YOUR ITEM FROM THE AUCTION TABLES** after the auction has ended. Volunteers from the auction committee will be handling all items and you can pick up your winning items in the designated check out area

If you want an item, we strongly encourage you to bid on it, and keep your eye on it through our online bidding system. Check out and payments will not be available until the conclusion of the Live Auction. **No Exceptions.** Should you have any problems, please find a member from the committee to assist you. 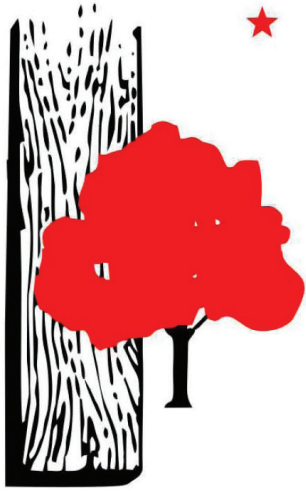

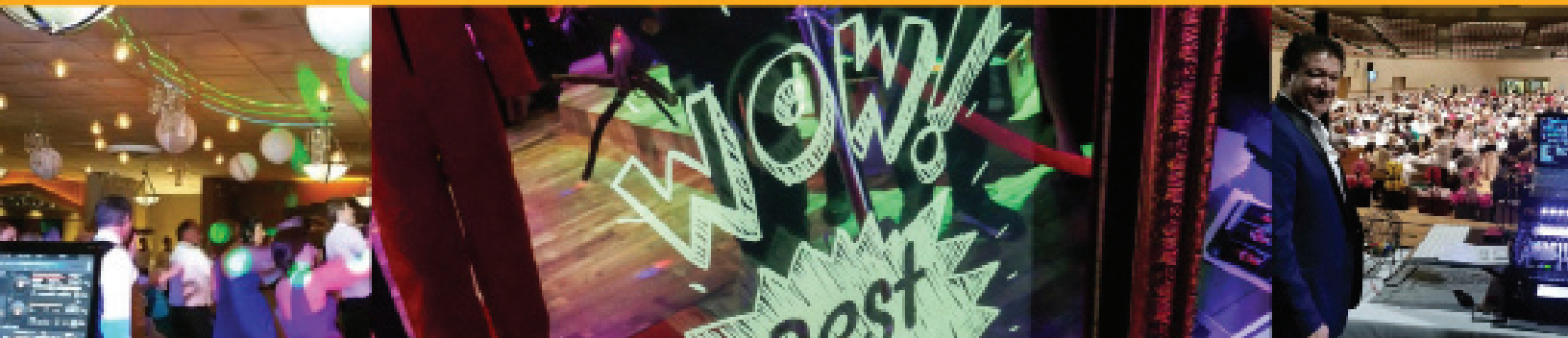
